#### SHOES

- Supportive shoes with straps/buckles/laces.
- No flashing or wheeled shoes or trainers.
- Sandals are only permitted in the summer.

#### HAIR

- Long hair must be tied back with school coloured clips and bows.
- Boy's hair should be kept at a reasonable length, not sculptured (e.g. Mohican) or with shaved patterns.

#### JEWELLERY/COSMETICS

- No jewellery is permitted in school (only earrings).
- Earrings should be gold studs only.
- Earrings must be removed before PE or if newly pierced, must be covered with a sticking plaster provided from home.
- No nail varnish is permitted.
- No make-up should be worn or brought into school.
- No tattoos (transfers).

The school will be sensitive to the needs of different cultures, races and religions and act reasonably in accommodating these needs when applying this uniform policy.
